Vineyard & Winemaking Notes

A 24% barrel fermentation lends richness to this salmon colored wine, made from a field blend of Cabernet Franc and Lemberger grapes. The Wiltberger Vineyard is located near the shore of Keuka Lake on a west-facing slope, enabling the grapes to receive sunshine long into the evenings and temperatures moderated by the vineyard's vicinity to the lake. Keuka Spring Vineyards continues its proud tradition of making the palest Rosé in the Finger Lakes.
