Vineyard & Winemaking Notes

Wilt (Wild) Berger (person of the mountain). This wine is named after the owners of Keuka Spring Vineyards, Len and Judy Wiltberger. It is a field blend of the red grapes in our vineyard, which were co-mingled when picked and fermented together. Following fermentation, the wine spent eight months in neutral French oak. It was then bottled and allowed to age in our cellar a year before release. The Wiltberger Vineyard is located near the shore of Keuka Lake on a west-facing slope, enabling the grapes to receive sunshine long into the evenings and temperatures moderated by the vineyard's vicinity to the lake.
