Clara's Red is named for our co-owner Len Wiltberger's grandmother, Clara. It's just the kind of wine she most enjoyed: sweet, refreshing, juicy, and fun. The key flavor in Clara's Red comes from Catawba, the only grape native to North American that we incorporate in our wines. It's grown lovingly by our decades-long friend Tom Hunt, owner of Joyful Vineyards, just a stone's throw from our winery.
