Crooked Lake White



Vineyard & Winemaking Notes

“Crooked Lake”, the original name settlers gave to Keuka Lake, graces the label of this smooth dry white wine. The little-known Seyval Blanc and Vidal Blanc grapes impart light citrus notes and a touch of minerality reminiscent of *Chablis*. We use a gentle overnight press cycle, ferment entirely in tanks, and forego malolactic fermentation to highlight the beautiful natural crispness of the wine.

Tasting Notes

We arrest fermentation of the two components of our popular Crooked Lake White just before the yeast has consumed all the sugars, leaving a touch of residual sugar to highlight the lovely natural citrus notes and round out the mid-palate and finish. Serve chilled.
